

Why do we celebrate Easter?

The Bible says that all people have sinned (look up Romans 3:23 in your Bible). Sin comes in between us and God. God wants us to be a part of his family. He wants us to live forever in heaven with him.

God sent his Son Jesus to earth to take the punishment for our sin. You heard that right—our sin! Jesus never sinned, but he was nailed to a cross and died to take the punishment for our sin. This is what we remember on Good Friday.

Jesus didn't stay dead! Three days later God raised Jesus from the dead. When he did, death and sin were defeated! This is what we celebrate on Easter day.


Now we are forgiven of our sin and we can be a part of God's family and have eternal life with him!

Why do we celebrate Easter with Easter eggs and chocolate bunnies

Easter eggs and bunnies can be used to celebrate Easter because they can point us to the truth about Jesus! Because of what Jesus did for us when he died on the cross and rose from the dead, we can have new life! A mother hen will sit on her eggs until she hatches her new baby chicks. These baby chicks represent the new life that God gives us through Jesus' death and resurrection. The empty egg shells left behind can represent the empty tomb that Jesus left behind when he rose from the dead.

Rabbits also have lots of babies. These little bunnies also represent the new life that we can have in Jesus. This new life means we are free from the power of sin. We no longer need to be afraid that we will be punished for the wrong things we have done. God forgives us and with his help we can live a blessed life while we wait for heaven.
